



I had missed the call, but there was a voice mail.

"Andrea, this is June. Bridget is missing. We've looked everywhere. Call me back." Bridget, who is a teenager, had been a young gir whom we had loved and mentored for many years. And now, she was gone. My heart paused, but my brain kicked into full gear. I know the statistics, I've heard the stories. Kids and teens go missing every day, and sometimes they never come back.

Human trafficking is the trade of humans, most commonly for the purpose of forced labor, sexual slavery, or commercial sexual exploitation for the trafficker or others. Most aften the exploitation happens by a family member, friend, older relative, or someone the victim aready has a relationship with. However, sometimes it occurs from online predators or someone who has targeted the individual for their purpose.

- \*Trafficking victims are subject to violations that in clude rape, forture, forced abortions, storvation, and threats of forturing family members. (The Protection Project)
- \*More than 1 MILUON children globally are forced into the sex trade every year. (UNICEF)
- \*The average age of entry into ferced prostitution is 12-14 years old.
- \*Human trafficking is phenomenally profitable and is the second largest criminal enterprise world wide. The annual estimated profit of human trafficking is in excess of \$32 BILLION. (United Nations)

It's easy to see these statistics and be disengaged. It's hard to fathom I MLUON children being trafficked. And too often, we believe it's a problem that happens "over there." However, human trafficking is flourishing in Oklahoma and there are countless voiceless victims who suffer without someone to advocate for them. The sad truth is, every day kids and teens are tricked, trapped, and trafficked.


That night, when I got the message about Bridget, my mind reeled with the endless possibilities of who could have her, what awful plans they had, and whether or not she would ever come home. The latest information we have about Bridget, is that she is alive, but she still isn't home. She has been tricked and trapped. As for the trafficked part, we can only pray that God will protect her from such.

Cn Sunday, September 24, the global Church will emphasize "Freedom Sunday". It's a day to rejcice with the victims who have been rescued from trafficking! It is also a day to pray fervently for those who are still enslaved. It is a day to advocate for the voiceless "Bridgets" in our communitles, who desperately need someone to care.

Woodward Naz wants to be part of the solution to this epidemic. Will you join us? Come on Freedom Sunday and learn more!






